# everyday *snack* napkins



## Supplies:

- \* 1 yd each of two coordinating fabrics
- \* sewing machine
- \* iron
- \* coordinating thread
- \* corner-pushing-pokey-thing-tool (that's a technical term, see step 3)

= 12 coordinating cloth napkins ]

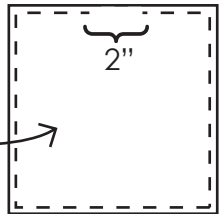
## HOW TO:

### Step 1

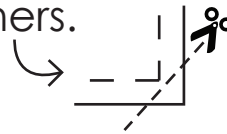
Cut fabrics into a total of 24 - 10" squares.

### Step 2

wrong side of fabric →

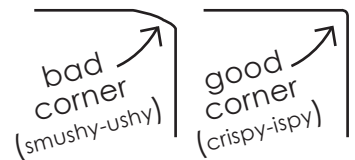


Place two pieces of same fabric right sides together and stitch 1/4" from edge. Leave a 2" opening along one side. Clip corners.



### Step 3

Turn napkin right side out through 2" opening and use preferred corner-pushing-pokey-thing-tool to push all 4 corners out into defined points. (my preferred tool is the rounded back end of a skinny paint brush, it's just perfect! not too sharp and not too fat!)



### Step 4

Iron  and topstitch around napkin.

### Step 5

Repeat **11** more times.

### Step 6

Wrap them up & **give them away!!**

(go ahead - wow the world with your mad sewing skills!)
